Our laboratory department is established in accordance with the international standard ISO 15189-2022. Clinical laboratory measurements form the scientific basis upon which medical diagnosis and management of patients is established.

Laboratory services at Yenepoya Specialty Hospital provide service 24 hours a day and 7 days a week with a primary focus on patient care.

Our services cover routine to advanced testing, including:

- Routine & Special Chemistry and Hormones
- Routine and Special Haematology, Coagulation, and Clinical Pathology
- Serology
- · Urine Cytology and PAP smear
- Emergency testing: blood gas analysis and cardiac markers

The laboratory team is guided by a highly dedicated Quality Manager, Mr. Gireesh Nayak, who is supported by experienced medical technicians, phlebotomists, and lab assistants, all collaborating together to deliver high-quality results.

Quality assurance: Precision of the test results is ensured by processing daily internal quality checks, and accuracy of the test results is ensured by participating in the international quality assurance program.

Our phlebotomy team is composed of highly trained phlebotomists who are skilled in difficult blood collections.
